

VIBF Congress

The Congress shall be the supreme authority of VIBF.

The Congress meets once every four (4) years. No quorum is required for a session of the Congress.

In order to optimise resources, VIBF will conduct its Congress in conjunction with the Virtus General Assembly.

With reference to the General Statutes at Item 14.1, the business to be conducted at the VIBF Congress includes:

- a. Approve the Agenda
- b. Adopt and modify the VIBF General Statutes
- c. Elect the President of VIBF for a maximum of two (2) four (4) year terms of office
- d. Elect the Vice-President of VIBF for a maximum of two (2) four (4) year terms of office
- e. Examine and approve all reports on VIBF activities to the members
- f. Grant the title of Honorary President, Honorary Member or Secretary Emeritus
- g. Examine and approve all reports, including the report of the Executive Committee, and other items on the agenda
- h. Ratify the decisions of the Executive Committee under Articles 10.2. and 15.1.2. g) (suspension of members)
- i. Decide on the expulsion of members as per Article 10.6.
- j. Declare the disbandment of VIBF
